Building Committee Up Date

The building committee has had two meetings since the last *E-scene*. We have been in conversation with several providers of manufactured buildings, some specializing in steel buildings and other in modular.

The steel building companies we have made contact with so far are not equipped to deliver a finished building. They simply put us a shell and leave the rest to others. This would leave us with the problem

of having to function as our own general contractor, an expertise we really don't have among ourselves. At the moment steel is not looking like the best option but we are waiting for more information.

On the modular side, we have been (primarily) talking with two different companies. Both deliver, to their customers, a finished building. In order to get the most building for our dollars we have created a simplified floor plan and spent our last meeting detailing that drawing. We marked the location of electrical outlets, windows (with sizes), etc. This detailed sketch is what contractors need in order to give us an accurate price estimate.

Along with this work the committee is also looking further into the City's code requirements. We will be required to have a licensed civil engineer develop a "site plan." This will include things like: parking lot lights, drainage and septic tank placement, utility lines and the foundation for the building.

Please keep us in your prayers, its very detailed work. Once we have collated all the necessary facts and figures we will make a presentation of our findings and recommendations. **Fr. Victor**
